- What:** An Exemplification of the Fourth Degree, Knights of Columbus, will be hosted by the **Master of the Fourth Degree, assisted by Sir Knight Francis Patrick Kennedy Assembly #1937.**
- Where:** St. Gerard Catholic School, 40 Foster Street, Winnipeg, Manitoba.
- When:** It will take place mid day on **Saturday, April 14th, 2012.**
- Times:** **10:45 am** - Roll Call; **11 am** - Orientation; **12 pm** - Exemplification; **5 pm** – Mass; 6:15 **pm** Banquet
- Qualifications:** Active 3rd Degree members, in good standing, after having completed their sixth month anniversary from First Degree initiation date. **First Degree on October 14th, 2011 or before.**
- Benefit:** Privilege to join the Colour Corps (only 4th Degree members are eligible); be addressed as **Sir Knight** and reach the pinnacle of the Order.
- Initiation Fee:** **\$100.00** per candidate. This includes Social Baldric, 4th Degree Lapel Pin and a lunch ticket. **Cheques are to be made payable to your sponsoring Assembly.**
- Other Fee:** Annual dues to the 4th Degree Assembly that you are joining. This fee varies from Assembly to Assembly, but is normally in the range of \$40.00 per year.
- Other Cost:** Spouse/Guest Banquet luncheon ticket cost of **\$35.00.** This is to be paid by advance registration. **Deadline for ticket purchase is April 1, 2012.**
- Application:** Form 4 to submitted, fully completed, by the applicant prior to deadline of April 1st, 2012.
- Attire:** Black tuxedo, black bow tie, black cummerbund, black shoes and socks; narrow pleated white tuxedo shirt with traditional lay down collar. (No wingtip collars or ruffles).
